Olathe Twilight Meet Recap

Despite having only half the squad, we came away with twice the success! Our Boys C-team got the meet kicked off for us with freshman **Zeke Van Gilder** (32nd) leading the way for the C-team. We didn't have enough for a team score but all 4 boys set PRs. The next race on the course was the JV Girls. Adeline Niermeier (1st) ran a tatcticaly perfect race waiting until the 2nd half of the race to make her move on the field WINNING the race in a big PR. Adeline was our first champion in any Olathe Twilight race in Southwest History. Despite the issue with the "notso" false start in the JV Boys race, **Zach Brewington** (50th) finished the race as our top boy. The rest of the JV boys had to run the race with the Varsity, making it a very packed starting line. I was really proud of the JV boys for handling the setback well. Austin Niermeier (275th) was the top BVSW boy in the JV boy in the group. We had lots of PR's and all finished well, once they hit the Track.

The Varsity Boys race was a slugfest against Iowa, Arkansas, Missouri & Kansas's best teams. We had a race strategy that was based on letting the race go out fast but holding back for the 2nd half & catching those that went out over their skies. The strategy went well for our top group who was able to move up in the field as a pack to the front of the race. Canyon Buehler (10th), Elijah Chavez (11th) & Alex Roberts (13th) all finished in the medals & within 3 seconds of each other. With Cameron Paschke (23rd) our top 4 runners put the race out of reach for some of the best teams in this part of the country. The boys ended up WINNING the championship race as a team by 10 points over perennial Iowa powerhouse, Dowling Catholic, 37 points over NXN qualifying, Bentonville HS & 60 points over the next best Kansas team. The results of this race shows the boys' team is in contention for NXN qualification at the Regional meet in Sioux Falls, SD in mid-November.
